Tools Required: Screwdriver, Scissors or Knife, Rubber Cement

Please read completely before attempting install.

1. Start at the center of the bottom edge of the license plate (Fig.1).

2. Push and wiggle the trim onto the plate and work your way around. Rubber cement can be used for stubborn areas that don't want to sit flush (Fig.2).
3. Once the trim is around the plate, cut the excess material so the ends join up. To avoid gaps where the ends meet, cut the trim as straight as possible.
4. Use the supplied bolt cover washers and screw the plate on the vehicle. Snap covers over the washers and bolts. Done!
